ORDER

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct 178th Street at grade across the Gardena-San Pedro Branch of Pacific Electric Railway Company at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6RC-14.82. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines 2' outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 30 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Std. No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by two Std. No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. 75-B).

Within 30 days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
