ORDER APPROVING WHARF FRANCHISE

Applicant, by verified petition, asks this Commission to approve an ordinance of the County of El Dorado, State of California, granting to applicant permission to construct, operate and maintain a wharf on Echo Lake in said County. The application filed by Edwin F. Smith, Supervisor of Eldorado National Forest, on behalf of the United States of America, does not request the right to collect tolls on said wharf.

Approval of this Commission to the grant of such franchise is required by the Harbors and Navigation Code, Section 4000. It appearing that such approval should be given, and that public hearing is not required. It is ordered that approval is hereby accorded for the construction, operation and maintenance of a wharf on Echo Lake in the

County of El Dorado by Edwin F. Smith, Supervisor of Eldorado National Forest, on behalf of the United States of America, as provided in Ordinance No. 119 of the Board of Supervisors of said County, adopted May 7, 1940.
