IT IS HEREBY FOUND AS & FACT that public convenience and necessity require and will require and San Diego Consolidated Gas

and Electric Company is hereby granted a certificate for the exercise of the rights and privileges granted it by the City of El Cajon, San Diego County, under its Ordinance No. 150, adopted May 27, 1935. This grant is subject to the condition, however, that San Diego Consolidated Gas and Electric Company, its successors or assigns, will never claim before this Commission, or any court or other public body, a value for the franchise or for the authority hereby granted in excess of the actual cost thereof.

This order shall be effective immediately.
