O P I N I O N

By this application Gayle R. and Ruby M. Green, doing business as Blairsden Stage Company, have petitioned the Commission for authority to temporarily suspend their automotive common carrier service for the transportation of passengers and property between Blairsden and Sierra City and intermediate points for the remainder of the present season.

As justification for the authority sought applicants allege that during the current season there have been few vacationists visiting the territory served by them, as a result of which the revenue derived from their present operations have been insufficient to meet their out-of-pocket operating costs thereof.

This does not appear to be a matter in which a public hearing is necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Gayle R. and Ruby M. Green, doing business as Blairsden Stage Company, are hereby authorized to

suspend their automotive common carrier service for the transportation of passengers and property between Blairsden and Sierra City and intermediate points for the remainder of the present season, subject to the following condition:

Applicants shall immediately file on at least five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public a time schedule, in triplicate, and a supplement to their tariffs, in triplicate, showing the suspension of service as herein authorized.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
