
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O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Reynolds Road and State Highway in the vicinity of Gigling, Monterey County, at the location described in the application, said crossing at Reynolds Road to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. EE-118.8 and that of State Highway as Crossing No. EE-118.9-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road and highway now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding the existing grades of said road and highway. Protection shall be by one additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign at Crossing No. EE-118.8 and by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals at Crossing No. EE-118.9-C. Applicant shall file copies of permits from the County of Monterey and the Department of Public Works for the respective crossings.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
