SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By supplemental application in this proceeding, filed on July 27, 1939, McGough Brothers Transportation Company asked this Commission for approval of a certain lease agreement covering the lease of a vessel to be operated between Santa Monica and Avalon, pursuant to the authority granted by the Commission's Decision No. 29507, dated February 1st, 1937, in Application No. 20867.

It appears from the record developed at the hearing on Case No. 4541, held at Los Angeles on July 24, 1940, that this service was not operated during the 1939 season, nor has it been operated during the present season, and the Order in that proceeding revokes the certificate which has been issued. Under these circumstances, any order approving the lease as asked for would be unnecessary.

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Supplemental Application No. 20867, dated July 27, 1939, be and the same is hereby dismissed.
