## Decision No. <u>33384</u>

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY LTD. for Certificate that Present and Future Public Convenience and Necessity Require or will Require the Construction and Operation by Applicant of an Electrical Transmission Line from Applicant's Chino Substation, located in San Bernardino County, California, to San Juan Capistrano, Orange County, California.

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## BY THE COMMISSION:

Southern California Edison Company, Ltd., has applied for authority, under Section 50(a) of the Public Utilities Act, to build an electrical transmission line and acquire necessary lands and rights to enable it to interchange electric energy with San Diego Consolidated Gas and Electric Company under the terms of an agreement heretofore approved by the Commission, in Decision No. 33066, following a public hearing on Application No. 23450. It was apparent to the Commission at the time of the approval of said agreement from evidence received at said hearing that construction of the facilities herein contemplated would be necessary to carry out the terms of said agreement.

It is evident therefore that the requested authority should be granted and that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary.

## <u>order</u>

It is hereby found as a fact that public convenience and necessity require and will require and Southern California Edison Company Ltd. is hereby granted a certificate for the building and operation of a high tension electrical transmission line from its substation at Chino, San Bernardino County, to its substation at San Juan Capistrano, Orange County, as more particularly described in that certain interchange agreement by and between Southern California Edison Company Ltd. and San Diego Consolidated

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Gas and Electric Company which was approved by the Commission's Decision No. 33066, dated May 6, 1940, and for the acquisition of lands, easements for rights of way and other rights essential to the building and operation thereof in order to accomplish the purpose of said interchange agreement.

This grant is subject to the condition that applicant, within thirty (30) days from the date hereof, shall file with the Railroad Commission of the State of California a written acceptance of the certificate hereby granted.

The effective date of this Order is the date hereof. Dated at San Francisco, California, this <u>30</u> day of <u>1940</u>.

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
