SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the declaration in the Commission's order in its Decision No. 33277, dated July 3, 1940, on Application No. 20083, reading as follows:

"THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the establishment and operation by Robert G. Anderson of an automotive service as a highway common carrier, as such term is defined in section 2-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of property between San Francisco, on the one hand, and San Rafael, Santa Rosa and Sebastopol and intermediate points, excluding San Rafael, on the other hand, over and along U. S. Highway No. 101 and the public highways between Santa Rosa and Sebastopol, and between Cotati and Sebastopol."

be amended to expressly name Hamilton Field as an intermediate point,
as follows:

"THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the establishment and operation by Robert G. Anderson of an automotive service as a highway common carrier, as such term is defined in section 2-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of property between San Francisco, on the one hand, and San Rafael, Hamilton Field, Santa Rosa and Sebastopol and intermediate points, excluding San Rafael, on the other hand, over and along U. S. Highway No. 101 and the public highways between Santa Rosa and Sebastopol and between Cotati and Sebastopol."

In all other respects Decision No. 33277 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
