ORDER APPROVING WHARF FRANCHISE

Applicant, by verified petition, asks this Commission to approve an ordinance of the County of Contra Costa, renewing a wharf franchise and permitting applicant to operate and maintain a wharf on certain lands adjacent to the southerly shore of the Straits of Carquinez, and within said County. The application does not request the right to collect tolls on said wharf.

Approval of this Commission to the grant of such franchise is required by the Harbors and Navigation Code, section 4000. It appearing that such approval should be given, and that public hearing is not required, IT IS ORDERED that approval is hereby accorded for the operation and maintenance of a wharf on the Straits of Carquinez in the County of Contra Costa by Bank of America National Trust and Savings Association, as provided in that certain ordinance of the Board of Supervisors of said County, adopted August 5, 1940, a copy of which is attached to the application herein.
