O R D E R

ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one side track at grade across Century Boulevard in the City of Lynwood, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. EG-490.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding the grade shown on the map (L.A. Division, Drawing No. 2221, Sheet 1 of 2) attached to the application. Applicant shall relocate southwest wigwag to west of said side track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
