BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, for authority to construct, maintain and operate a side track, at grade, across Hale Avenue, in the County of San Diego, State of California.

O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Hale Avenue in Escondido, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2E-20.4. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Std. No. 2, of G. O. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 4%. Protection shall be by the existing Std. No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
