ORDER

The verified application of The Western Pacific Railroad Company discloses that said company has been granted permission by the Interstate Commerce Commission to abandon its Calpine Branch, and that the continued maintenance of non-agency stations at Summitt, Fir and Calpine is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Summitt, Fir and Calpine, Counties of Plumas and Sierra, to eliminate said names from its station records, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
