O R D E R

The County of Fresno is authorized to construct Eleventh Street at grade across the tracks of Fresno Interurban Railroad (The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company), near the City of Fresno, Fresno County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2G-1.8. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Fresno Interurban Railroad (The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company), shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
