FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing therefor

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the figure \$2~~9~~⁹,293,750 be substituted for the figure \$29,093,750 appearing on page 3 of the opinion in Decision No. 33487, dated September 17, 1940. *H. M.*

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the first paragraph of the order in said Decision No. 33487, dated September 17, 1940, reading:

"The Commission having considered the request of Southern California Gas Company, and it being of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a hearing is necessary, that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for by the issue of said \$30,000,000 of First Mortgage Bonds, 3-1/4% Series due 1970, is reasonably required for the purposes herein indicated,

and that the expenditures for said purposes, except the payment of expenses incident to the issue of said bonds, are not in whole, or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income, and that this application should be granted as provided in this order, therefore"

be and the same is hereby amended so as to read:

"The Commission having considered the request of Southern California Gas Company, and it being of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a hearing is necessary, that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for by the issue of said \$30,000,000 of First Mortgage Bonds, ~~5-7-70~~^{3 1/4%} Series due 1970, is reasonably required for the purposes herein indicated, and that the expenditures for said purposes, except the payment of expenses incident to the issue of said bonds and interest to November 1, 1940 on the bonds to be redeemed, are not in whole, or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income, and that this application should be granted as provided in this order, therefore"

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 33487, dated September 17, 1940, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
