In the Matter of the Application of the CITY OF HEALDSBURG, a municipal corporation, for an order authorizing the widening of the crossing of Front Street of said city with the right of way of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company.

ORDER

City of Healdsburg is suthorized to widen Front Street across main line of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company in that city, as described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 5-67.7. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than the graded and traveled portion of said street, and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. C. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
