FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In this Commission's Decision No. 33243 dated June 25, 1940, it was ordered among other things that public convenience and necessity require the operation of a water system by Elmer L. Cupp in a portion of the Joseph Siino Subdivision in Contra Costa County, and upon the installation of adequate facilities a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate in the said area would be granted, and such installation now having been completed and it appearing that the certificate should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is hereby granted to Elmer L. Cupp to operate a public utility for the sale and distribution of water in Blocks 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the Joseph Siino Subdivision, as shown on a map filed with the County Recorder in Volume 21 of Maps on page 590 and as also shown on a map attached to the application herein marked "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Elmer L. Cupp
be and he is hereby authorized on the date of this Order
to place in effect for service in the above described area
that schedule of rates established in this Commission's
Decision No. 33243 for service in the Bel-Air Tract.
