FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

On July 30, 1940, the Commission issued its Decision No. 33373 on the above-entitled matter which authorized Bruce W. Robb to purchase from W. W. Powers, as receiver of the estate of Robb and Bailey, a passenger stage operative right between the intersection of Del Monte and Rider Avenues, East Salinas, and Salinas Airport, West Salinas, and intermediate points. Such authority was granted subject to the condition that it would lapse and become void if the conditions attached thereto were not complied with within the times fixed within the order of said Decision No. 33373. The conditions were not complied with and the authority for transfer is now void.

On September 21, 1940, applicants filed a supplemental application requesting the Commission to regrant the authority heretofore granted by said Decision No. 33373 and to extend the time to comply with the conditions thereof.

In support of such request applicants alleged that due to an oversight and misunderstanding they failed to comply with the conditions of said Decision No. 33373.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the order and the conditions contained in Decision No. 33373, dated July 30, 1940, in the above-entitled proceeding, and each and all of the terms and provisions thereof, excepting the effective date of said Decision No. 33373, be and they are hereby adopted and made a part hereof, by reference, to the same extent and with the same force and effect as though the same were here set forth in full, provided, however, that conditions 3 and 4 of said conditions shall be modified to provide for one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
