Southern Pacific Company has made application for author-
ity under Section 51(a) of the Public Utilities Act to grant an
easement to the Town of Emeryville across certain lands in said
town. Such authority is required by a Title Company in order to
clear title to a parcel of land desired by the town for street
purposes.

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to grant to
the Town of Emeryville an easement for street or highway purposes
upon and across certain lands in said Town of Emeryville as described
in the application and shown on blue print map C.E. Drawing 16199,
Sheet No. 1, attached thereto. This order shall not be construed as
authorizing the construction or the opening to public use and travel
of a crossing with any railroad track location on said described
land.

The authority herein granted shall lapse and become null
and void unless exercised within one year from the date of this
order.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
