ORDER

ORIGINAL

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across the intersection of Commonwealth and Palm Avenues in Alhambra, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6DB-8.60. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal to Standard No. 4 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign now in place. (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall, within sixty (60) days, submit a certified copy of a franchise or permit from the City of Alhambra for the construction of said crossing at grade and, in the event that this is not done, the authorization herein granted for the installation of said crossing shall then lapse and become void, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
