SILLS, relating to the sale by the former and purchase by the latter of surplus water for mining purposes in Placer County.

## ORDER

In this application Pacific Cas and Electric Company, a corporation, asks for authority to enter into an agreement with F. W. Sills for the sale and diversion of such quantity of excess water as the Pacific Cas and Electric Company may have available in its Eastside Canal, Placer County. Deliveries are to be made from said canal and the flow is not to exceed ten (10) miner's inches. (1) The water to be purchased is to be used exclusively for mining purposes and is to be the water which is in excess of that required by the Pacific Cas and Electric Company to provide for its regular irrigation and

<sup>(1)</sup> A miner's inch for the purpose hereof shall mean a continuous flow of water equivalent to 1.5 cubic feet per minute.

domestic service. This agreement is to be effective for a period of one year and from month to month thereafter for a period not exceeding six months.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the sale and delivery of excess water to F. W. Sills under the same terms and conditions substantially as set forth in Exhibit "A" of Exhibit No. 1 which is attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference. The amounts and the period of diversion provided therein are at all times to be subject to the authority of the Commission in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Cas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of this agreement as finally consummated.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Cas and Electric Company, a corporation, notify this Commission of the date of termination of said agreement within thirty (30) days thereof.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
