ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Cavin for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof as a station where freight in carload lots only will be received or delivered is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to change the classification of its non-agency station of Cavin, County of Ventura, from a Class "B" station to a Class "E" station where freight will not be received or delivered, and to cancel all freight tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
