SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Key System, by its application filed December 5, 1940, requests that the Commission find that the service rendered by it is urban service, as defined in General Order No. 93-A, exempting it from all the rules and regulations not applicable to urban service.

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Key System is granted permission on and after January 2, 1941, to comply with the rules and regulations of General Order No. 93-A which apply to urban service on its motor coach operations between Alameda County, Contra Costa County, and the City and County of San Francisco, with the exception, however, that it must comply with all of the provisions of Part IV of said General Order covering Time Tables, Rules, and Regulations.

The effective date of this order shall be the tenth (10th) day after the date hereof.
