O R D E R

County of Sacramento is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at grade across main line of Sacramento Northern Railway near Del Paso Heights, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. ³ E-98.9-D. *HGM*
 Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Sacramento Northern Railway shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not more than five feet and grades of approach approximately as shown on the profile attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
