ORDER

The verified application of Northwestern Facific Railroad Company discloses that no less-than-carload freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Wilfred during the year ended September 30, 1940, and that continued maintenance of said station as a Class "C" station, at which freight in less-than-carload lots will be received or delivered, is not necessary. Applicant proposes to maintain said station as a Class "B" non-agency station where only freight in carload lots will be received or delivered.

Good Cause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to change the classification of its non-agency station of Tilfred, Sonoma County, from Class "C" to Class "B" and to make changes in its tariifs accordingly on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after putting into effect the changes authorized herein applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
