OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Sacramento River Warehouse Company, a corporation, seeks authority to grant to the Sacramento and San Joaquin Drainage District, a public corporation, a right-of-way for the construction of a levee over lands in the City of Colusa upon which a warehouse building is situated. The Drainage District requires the right-of-way in order that it and other public agencies can reconstruct the Sacramento River levee in the City of Colusa. A copy of the agreement specifying the terms under which the rightof-way is proposed to be granted to the Drainage District is attached to the application.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Sacramento River Warehouse Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to grant to the Sacramento and San Joaquin Drainage District, a
