O P I N I O N

Harry A. Leonard, as administrator of the estate of H. B. Leonard, requests authority to abandon all highway common carrier operations created by the Commission's Decision No. 16874, dated June 10, 1926, on Application No. 12033, which authorized service between Hollister, Tres Pinos, San Benito, Alpine Mine, King City, and intermediate points.

As justification for the authority sought it is averred that no revenue is being derived from the service and that there is no public demand therefor.

This does not appear to be a matter in which a public hearing is necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Harry A. Leonard, administrator of the estate of H. B. Leonard, is hereby authorized to abandon all highway common carrier service between Hollister and King City via Tres Pinos, San Benito, and Alpine Mine, and the operative right therefor created by Decision No. 16874, dated June 10, 1926, is hereby revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all tariffs and time schedules governing the operation proposed to be abandoned are hereby cancelled.
