In the Matter of Application of HOLTON INTER-URBAN RAILWAY COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a spur track across Holt Avenue and an unnamed alley between Holt Avenue and Fern Avenue, in the City of Holtville, County of Imperial, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Holton Interurban Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Holt Avenue and an unnamed alley in the City of Holtville, Imperial County, at the location described in the application. Holt Avenue and said alley are not traveled at the point of crossing. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be such that grades of approach not exceeding one (1) per cent will be feasible in the event that the construction of an opening of Holt Avenue and the alley across said spur track shall hereafter be authorized and so that said grade crossing may be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
