FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph one of the order in Decision No. 33753, dated December 21, 1940, reading:

"1. Southern Counties Gas Company of California may, on or before May 1, 1941, execute a first mortgage indenture substantially in the same form as the first mortgage indenture filed in this proceeding on December 18, 1940, as Exhibit "B," provided, that the authority herein granted to execute said mortgage indenture is for the purpose of this proceeding only, and is granted only insofar as this Commission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities Act and is not intended as an approval of said mortgage indenture as to such other legal requirements to which said mortgage indenture may be subject, and provided further, that said authority does not relieve applicant from the obligation of keeping its books and accounting records in the manner prescribed by the Railroad Commission nor from the obligation of filing with the Railroad Commission applications for permission to issue bonds in addition to those herein authorized to be issued."

be, and the same is hereby, amended so as to read:

1. Southern Counties Gas Company of California may, on or before May 1, 1941, execute a first mortgage indenture substantially in the same form as the first mortgage indenture filed in this proceeding on January 15, 1941, provided, that the authority herein granted to execute said mortgage indenture is for the purpose of this proceeding only, and is granted only insofar as this Commission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities Act and is not intended as an approval of said mortgage indenture as to such other legal requirements to which said mortgage indenture may be subject, and provided further, that said authority does not relieve applicant from the obligation of keeping its books and accounting records in the manner prescribed by the Railroad Commission nor from the obligation of filing with the Railroad Commission applications for permission to issue bonds in addition to those herein authorized to be issued.
