Good Cause Appearing IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that condition (1) of the order in Decision No. 33781 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1) Cencel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all passenger train time schedules between Tracy and Elmhurst, via Niles.

For all other purposes Decision No. 33781 shall remain in. full force and effect.
