RKBEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA In the Matter of the Application of THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for ORIGINAL authority to remove certain protective devices at four crossings of applicant's lines of railway in the Application No. 23882 State of California, and to substitute in lieu thereof new and/or additional protective devices of the kinds and at the locations hereinafter specifically set forth. BY THE COMMISSION: ORDER The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company has requested authority to make changes in crossing protection at four grade crossings with its lines in the State of California. pears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the proposed changes in protection are in the public interest, therefore IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is hereby authorized to make changes in crossing protection as follows: Crossing No. 2-1001.9, Palm Avenue, Fresno - Install two flashing lights, Standard No. 8 signals (G.O. No. 75-B), in place of the existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign. Solano Avenue, Albany - Install two flashing light signals, Standard No. 7 (G.O. No. 75-B), in place of the existing wigwag and standard crossing sign. Crossing No. 2K-6.5, Crossing No.2-1057.7, Cox Ferry Road, Merced - Install two flashing light signals, Standard No. 8 (G.O. No. 75-B), in place of one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. Santa Anita Avenue, Lamanda Park - Install two flashing light signals, Standard No. 8 (G.O. No. 75-B), modified Crossing No. 2-128.3, to provide for installation of the signal on a cantilever arm, in place of one wigwag and Standard No. 1 crossing sign. -1Within thirty days thereafter applicant shall notify the Commission of the completion of the installations herein authorized. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
