

Decision No. 33223

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the applications of  
CENTRAL MENDOCINO COUNTY POWER COMPANY and  
CALIFORNIA PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY for an  
order:

(a) authorizing Central Mendocino  
County Power Company to transfer and convey  
its utility assets and properties to Cali-  
fornia Public Service Company;

(b) expressly authorizing California  
Public Service Company to acquire from  
Central Mendocino County Power Company the  
Utility assets and properties of Central  
Mendocino County Power Company;

(c) authorizing California Public Ser-  
vice Company to issue an additional  
\$140,000 principal amount of its First  
Mortgage Bonds, Series B 4-1/4%, due November  
1, 1964; and

(d) authorizing California Public Ser-  
vice Company to issue \$95,000 aggregate par  
value of its capital stock (3,800 shares at  
the par value of \$25 each).
