ORDER

The County of Riverside is authorized to construct 8th
Street and 37th Street at grade across the Perris Branch of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in the vicinity of March
Field, in said county. The crossing at 8th Street shall be identified
as Crossing No. 2X-11.5, and that at 37th Street shall be identified
as Crossing No. 2X-9.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of
rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear
maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings shall be not
less than 40 feet, and grades of approach not greater than 3 per cent.
Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72.
Protection at each crossing shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing
sign (G.O. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
