FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 32960 of April 2, 1940, in the above entitled application, A.M. Gross and F. Gross, copartners doing business as Gross Systems, were authorized to transport property for Certified Grocers, Inc. at rates less than the established minimum rates. The authority is limited to transportation from Certified Grocers' warehouse situated in the City of Vernon to points in southern California not more than 100 constructive miles distant therefrom, and to transportation of returned merchandise. It will expire April 12, 1941. By supplemental application, filed February 20, 1941, a one-year extension of the authority is sought. Applicants allege that since the authority was granted they have experienced no material change in the conditions surrounding this transportation.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the proposed extension of the authority is justified. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted A.M. Gross and F. Gross, copartners doing business as Gross Systems, by Decision No. 32960 of April 2, 1940, in the above entitled application, be and it is hereby extended to April 12, 1942, unless earlier changed, cancelled or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
