## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, one of the applicants in the above numbered proceeding, having inadvertently failed to exercise the right to abandon its station at Dow, in the County of Kern, as authorized in Decision No. 31850, dated March 20, 1939, within the limit of time set forth in said decision, and having requested that the Commission make a supplemental order authorizing the applicant to abandon said station,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to abandon its station of Dow, in the County of Kern, to eliminate said name from its station records, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
