BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By prior decision in the above entitled proceeding, minimum rates, rules and regulations have been established for the transportation of property by city, radial highway common, highway contract, and common carriers. Certain of these rates are published in the form of class rates subject to ratings contained in Western Classification No. 68, C.R.C.-W.C. No. 1 of R. C. Fyfe, Agent, (supplements thereto or reissues thereof) or to exceptions to said Classification; others are published in the form of commodity rates applying on particular articles or groups of articles. Exceptions to the Classification and commodity items do not in all instances describe specifically the article or articles upon which they apply; at times they refer to grouped descriptions contained in said Classification No. 68. On April 1, 1941, this Classification is to be superseded by Western Classification No. 69, C.R.C. No. 2 of R.C. Fyfe, Agent.<sup>1</sup> This latter classification does not, in all instances, use the same group or generic descriptions. Under the circumstances, outstanding minimum rate orders referring to Western Classification No. 68 for descriptions should be modified so that upon cancellation of said Classification No. 68, they will refer to descriptions contained in Classification No. 69. At the same time, other, but related, changes will be made in these orders to make reference to<sup>2</sup> current tariff publications and to provide uniform descriptions.

In many respects it has already been so superseded.

For example: Where reference is made to tariff publications and their reissues, reissued publications will be named in place of those in effect when prior orders were entered; where tariff items were renumbered in reissuing publications to which reference is made, the new numbers will be shown; where descriptions of the property in the orders coincide with generic headings of the Western Classification, they will be amended so as to refer to that classification for determination of the individual articles described in the orders; and where descriptions of articles are duplicated in the orders, superfluous entries will be eliminated.



