OPINION AND ORDER

ORIGINAL

By Decision No. 32702 of January 2, 1940, in Application No. 22795, Stephen W. Bowman, a highway contract carrier, was authorized to transport specified property between Hollister and San Benito and intermediate points at rates less than the established minimum rates. The authority expired January 2, 1941. By this application, filed February 27, 1941, Bowman seeks its reinstatement. He alleges that operating conditions have not changed materially since the original authority was granted, and that during its effectiveness rates charged thereunder returned a satisfactory profit.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted. Due, however, to the possibility that the conditions under which this service is rendered may change at any time the authority will be limited to a one-year period.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Stephen W. Bowman be and he is hereby authorized to transport property as a highway contract carrier at rates less than the established minimum rates but not less than the rates set forth in Appendix "A" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

This authority shall expire one (1) year from the effective date of the order unless changed, canceled or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.

The following rates will apply as minimum for transportation by Stephen W. Bowman as a contract carrier between Hollister and San Benito and intermediate points:
