BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at Thayer Avenue across its Sawtelle Line at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6S-11.86-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Width of crossing shall be not more than 6 feet and protection shall be by special pedestrian signs of a type similar to those previously approved for pedestrian crossing protection at other locations on the system of Pacific Electric Railway Company.

Within 30 days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
