BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Stockton Port District is authorized to construct at grade Industrial Road No. 848 across the main track of the Stockton Public Belt Railroad near Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 59A-0.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Stockton Public Belt Railroad shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
