ORDER

The North Fork Ditch Company having filed on January 6, 1941, a revised schedule of rates to supersede the presently effective tariffs and the Commission having suspended the filing thereof and instituted the instant proceeding into the propriety of said revised rates, and written request now having been made by North Fork Ditch Company for the withdrawal of the entire filing of January 6, 1941, and no further investigation or public hearing appearing to be necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the said revised schedules of rates filed by said North Fork Ditch Company on January 6, 1941, and entitled "Retail Irrigation Service," "Wholesale Irrigation Service," "Domestic Service," "Intermittent Mining Service - Retail," and "Mining Service - Wholesale," respectively, be and they are hereby permanently suspended.
