SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Part I of the Order in Decision No. 33688, dated December 3, 1940, the Commission rendered a certificate to Pacific Electric Railway Company authorizing an extension of its Los Angeles-Redondo Beach Motor Coach Line from Redondo Beach to West Palos Verdes Drive, but according grantee the privilege of discontinuing service after a trial of about ninety days if the revenue therefrom proved insufficient, which trial period would terminate March 23, 1941.

It now appearing that Pacific Electric Railway Company does not propose to invoke the discontinuance privilege referred to but is willing to continue the service for a further period, it is proper that Part I of the Order in Decision No. 33688 now be amended by striking the clause from the order contained therein.

Good Cause Appearing ~~IT~~ IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (5) of Part I of the Order in Decision No. 33688, appearing on sheets 10 and 11 of said order, be and the same is hereby revoked and shall have no further force and effect.
