IT IS HEPEBY OFDERED that the portion of the Commission's Decision No. 33354, dated July 23, 1940, in the above-numbered proceeding, wherein the monthly quantity rates for water sold are established and set forth on page seven (7) of the original Opinion and Order herein, be and it is hereby modified and amended to read as follows:

IT IS HERELY FURTHER ORDERED that Sen Gabriel Valley Water Service be and it is hereby authorized and directed to file in quadruplicate with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Supplemental Order, the schedule of rates established

and set forth in said Decision No. 33354 and as herein modified and amended, and which schedule as so amended shall be charged for all water service rendered on and after the <u>lst</u> day of <u>April</u>, 1941, to its consumers in the area heretofore described and certificated in said Decision No. 33354.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said Decision No. 33354 shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
