## OPINION AND ORDER

In this application Pacific Cas and Electric Company, hereinafter sometimes referred to as Applicant, requests authority to enter into a written agreement with Rainier Brewing Company, hereinafter sometimes called Customer, relating to the sale and delivery of surplus natural gas as shall during the term of the agreement be required for fuel purposes in the operation of Customer's high-pressure boilers (1,175 h.p. rated capacity) at its plant located at 1550 Bryant Street, San Francisco, California. A copy of the proposed agreement marked Exhibit "A" is attached to and made a part of the application.

Some of the more important features and conditions of said proposed agreement may be set forth. Applicant agrees, if and when it shall have surplus gas available, to sell and deliver to Customer, and the latter agrees to purchase from the former, such quantities of the same as shall during the term of the

natural gas service to said Rainier Brewing Company at the rates and under the terms and conditions set forth in said agreement; provided, however, that the authority herein granted shall not be taken as limiting the Commission's authority to modify or set aside such agreement by appropriate order.

Pacific Cas and Electric Company shall file two copies of the agreement with the Commission within thirty (30) days after its execution.

Authority herein granted shall become effective as of the date hereof.
