In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades of the State highway and the Southern Pacific Railroad near Keene, in the County of Kern, State of California.

ORDER

In Decision No. 33765 in the above entitled application the Commission authorized the construction of a grade separation of State highway with the tracks of Southern Pacific Company near Keene, Kern County, and said decision provided that within one hundred and twenty (120) days from the date of the order plans for the structure be filed with the Commission. Applicant is constructing the substructure of this grade separation in connection with adjacent grading operations but does not expect to proceed with the building of the superstructure at this time. An extension of time of two years in which to file the plans has been requested.

This request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time limit for filing the plans as provided in Decision No. 33765, dated December 21, 1940, is hereby extended to April 21, 1943.

In all other respects Decision No. 33765 shall remain in full force and effect.
