FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The City of Glendale, having on March 27, 1941, filed a written request, asking that protection of the two Standard No. 3 wigwags specified on Page 1 of Decision No. 33925 be changed to two Standard No. 4 wigwags in order to comply with terms of an agreement in effect between applicant and Pacific Electric Railway Company at this location; it appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that said request should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 33925, dated February 18, 1941, is hereby amended by substituting two Standard No. 4 wigwags (G. O. 75-B) in lieu of two Standard No. 3 wigwags.

In all other respects Decision No. 33925 shall remain in full force and effect.
