San Joaquin Associated Telephone Company, operating a general telephone business in Fowler, Fresno County, California, and elsewhere, requests authority to waive certain charges for changing from one type of telephone set to another in its Fowler exchange.

Applicant is preparing to convert its exchange at Fowler from manual magneto to common battery dial operation. This change will require the replacement of manual station equipment, now in use, by dial-equipped telephones. It is desired to allow the subscribers the privilege of changing from one type of telephone set to another without the application of the change of instrument charge of \$1.50, if the change is requested by the subscriber before the installation of the dial-equipped telephone during the cutover period.

The Commission heretofore has authorized the waiving of the change of instrument charges during periods of conversion of exchanges from manual to dial operation under conditions similar to those at Fowler. We are of the opinion that the re-

quest of Applicant herein is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.

Sen Joaquim Associated Telephone Company having made application to the Railroad Commission for authority to waive certain change of telephone instrument charges for the period Of the CONVERSION of the Fowler exchange to dial operation and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is required,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA hereby finds as a fact that the waiving of the charges referred to in the preceding Opinion is justified, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Joaquin Associated Telephone Company may file and make effective, subsequent to the date of this Order, a revised Move and Change Charges Schedule as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to the application.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that San Joaquin Associated Telephone Company, on or before August 1, 1941, shall file with the Railroad Commission and make effective within five days a Move and Change Charges Schedule for its Fowler exchange, as set forth in Exhibit "B" attached to the application. $A = -\hat{H}$
