BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company has made application for permission to construct an industrial roadway at grade across its main line and certain other tracks in the City of Oakland, Alameda County. This roadway is being constructed to serve property owned by applicant and leased to the Defense Plant Corporation and, while not to be dedicated as a public street, will be used by persons employed at the shipbuilding plant on the leased property and by certain other persons.

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct an industrial roadway at grade across its main line and other tracks at the location described in the application and shown on Exhibit "A" attached to said application. Suid crossing shall be identified as Crossing No. 4-5.4. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. . 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign and two Standard No. 6 flashing light signals installed substantially as shown on Exhibit "A."

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
