O R D E R


Southern Pacific Company has made application for authority to close its seasonal agency at Acampo, San Joaquin County, and to maintain this station as a non-agency. Applicant now maintains an agent at this point during the months of August, September, and October and alleges that the maintenance of such agency does not serve any public need in view of the fact that the principal consignors and consignees of freight prefer to handle their business at the agency of Lodi, 2.9 miles west. An agency station is also maintained at Galt, 5.5 miles to the east.



It appears that a public hearing is not necessary in this matter and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is authorized to close its seasonal agency at Acampo, San Joaquin County, and to amend its tariffs and rules accordingly, provided that applicant shall continue to maintain said Acampo Station as a non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
