

BY THE COMMISSION:

<u>O P I N I O N</u>

Pacific Greyhound Lines, by the above-entitled application, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to operate as a common carrier of passengers, baggage and express between Seeley and Camp Seeley.

Decision No. 23244 in Application No. 16989 granted applicant the right to operate between San Diego and El Centro via Seeley. Camp Seeley is located approximately two miles north of Seeley.

It is alleged in the application that the United States Army has just completed barracks and other facilities at Camp Seeley. The Eleventh Cavalry is now stationed at the camp.

No common carrier passenger service is available at the camp. The men stationed there are desirous of obtaining public transportation between the camp and towns situated nearby.

Pacific Greyhound Lines asks that if this certificate is granted the rights created hereby be deemed an extension and enlargement of its existing rights and be consolidated therewith. Applicant proposes to charge a fare of ten cents for a one-way ticket and twenty cents round trip.


Full consideration has been given to this matter. The Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing is unnecessary and that public convenience and necessity require that this application be granted.

<u>O R D E R</u>

IT IS ORDERED that a cortificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is granted to Pacific Greyhound Lines authorizing it to operate an automotive passenger stage service, as that term is defined in section 22 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between Seeley and Camp Seeley, which certificate shall be consolidated with and made a part of the rights granted to Pacific Greyhound Lines by Decision No. 23244, subject to the following restriction:

> In the transportation of express between Seeley and Camp Secley no single shipment shall be accepted for shipment that weighs in excess of 100 pounds, and all express must be transported in passenger vehicles only, except that as to property transported for or through the agency of Railway Express Agency, Inc., and milk and cream and empty containers of such commodities when being transported to or from a rail junction point in connection with rail transportation to which said shipments, restrictions as to weight and vehicle shall not apply.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the operation of said passenger stage service pursuant to the foregoing certificate, Pacific Greyhound Lines shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- 1. File a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date hereof.
- 2. Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such at any time by further order, conduct said passenger stage operations over and along county road "R."
- 3. Comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 by filing tariffs in conformity therewith in triplicate, and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this order and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
