BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct Road III-Sac-3-B at separated grades over the tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company and Sacramento Northern Railway near North Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4-140.3-A and Crossing No. 8-95.8-A. Applicant shall bear construction and maintenance expense. Applicant shall file with the Commission within one hundred and twenty days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing approved by The Western Pacific Railroad Company and Sacramento Northern Railway. Clearances shall be such that they will conform to the provisions of G. O. No. 26-C, if and when the railroad tracks are raised to the ultimate elevation determined by the State Reclamation Board.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
