## ORDER

County of Santa Cruz is authorized to reconstruct the crossing of Aptos Beach Drive at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company near Aptos, Santa Cruz County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, identified as Crossing No. EC-67-A. Applicant shall bear construction and maintenance expense. Applicant shall file with the Commission within one hundred and twenty days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G.O. No. 26-C. During construction only overhead clearances of twenty feet may be maintained, provided train speeds do not exceed twenty miles per hour and train crows are notified by bulletin or train order of said impaired clearances.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. shall be offective immediately.
